Further, (I) (we) do hereby agree to repair at (my) (our) own expense and to the satisfaction of the Brown County Highway Engineer, any damage to the highways, structures, signs, or etc., which was caused as a result of this movement. The work of repair may be done by the Brown County Highway Dept. and costs charged to and paid by the applicant.

(I) (We) also do hereby agree to comply with all regulations, provisions and limitations which apply to this movement if permission is granted.

General Conditions

1. Minimum 24 hours notice for permits to be approved.
2. Minimum \$1,500,000 bodily injury & property damage liability & \$1,500,000 combined single limit automobile liability must be carried.
3. All moving equipment must be mounted on pneumatic tires.
4. Load limit is not to exceed any State, County or Local Laws.
5. Pilot cars and/or Flagmen are required front and rear for directing traffic if load width crosses centerline or is 16 feet wide or wider. Pilot cars shall be equipped with flashing amber lights on the top of the vehicle.
6. Movement within incorporated or congested areas shall be coordinated with local law enforcement.
7. Arrangements shall be made by the permittee with all utility companies for overhead wires or cables.
8. No movement shall be made when roads are soft, wet, slippery or if visibility is poor.
9. There shall be no movement on Holidays or Holiday weekends.
10. Movement shall be during daylight hours only unless specifically stated on the face of this permit.
11. Permission for movement over roads other than County Highways must be obtained from authorities under whose jurisdiction such roads come.
12. Movement of all buildings 16 feet wide by 20 feet long or larger shall be moved by a licensed building mover as per statute 221.81. A license can be obtained by calling the Department of Transportation at 651-405-6060. This does not include manufactured homes, modular homes or farmers moving their own farm buildings.
13. The Permittee shall comply with all rules posted on any bridges or underpasses over or under which he shall travel and assume all risks relative thereto. No signs, guard rails or other county or private property shall be moved unless written authority is given.
14. Red, yellow or orange flags at least 18 inches square must be placed at the extreme tip of the overhang when a vehicle or its load exceeds 9 feet in width.
