

BROWN COUNTY ORDINANCE
OVER-WIDTH MANUFACTURED HOME
RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, prior to the 1985 amendment, Minn. Stat. 169.86 Subd. 1, provided, inter alia, that County authorities were prohibited from issuing a special permit to move an “over-width, over-length” manufactured home on the highways under the county’s jurisdiction until receipt of a statement from the County Auditor and Treasurer that all personal property taxes assessed on the unit had been paid; and

WHEREAS, the 1985 amendment to Minn. Stat. 169.86 Subd.1 has caused an increase in delinquent mobile home taxes throughout the County of Brown; and

WHEREAS, collection efforts of delinquent mobile home taxes has increased the work load for the Brown county Sheriff’s Department; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General for the State of Minnesota has issued an opinion stating that counties are permitted to establish an ordinance requiring the payment of taxes assessed on a manufactured mobile home prior to its removal from the County by means of transportation on County Highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Brown County Board of Commissioners ordains as follows:

A special permit is required to move an “over-width, over-length” manufactured home on the highways under the jurisdiction of Brown County, Minnesota and that no such special permit shall be issued until receipt of a statement from the county Auditor and Treasurer that all personal property taxes assessed on the unit has been paid.
