

**BROWN COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO 1991-04
COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Minn. Stat. Sec. 400.08 the Brown County Board of Commissioners, by Resolution, has established boundaries for solid waste management service areas within the county and has imposed reasonable charges for solid waste management and disposal; and

WHEREAS, to implement said county recycling Program the County has entered into contracts with refuse haulers for pickup and disposal of recyclable materials within Brown county; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the public interest to prohibit the unauthorized collection of recyclables; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing, after due notice, as provided by Law has been conducted in regard to this Ordinance.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF BROWN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1 PROHIBITION

It shall be unlawful for any person who is not authorized by Brown County to remove, take for salvage or destroy any recyclable materials, including, but not limited to, aluminum recyclables, can recyclables, corrugated cardboard, glass recyclables, paper recyclables or plastic recyclables that have been set out for curbside collection and in drop box collection sites.

SECTION 2 VIOLATION AND PENALTY

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished as provided by Law. A separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day, or portion thereof, during which any violation of this Ordinance is committed, continued or permitted.

SECTION 3 EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective following the adoption by the county Board of Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Ordinance is hereby adopted this 27th day of June, 1991.

IT IS ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners that a full, true and correct copy of this Ordinance shall be certified to by the County Auditor who shall forthwith file of record such certified copy in the office of the recorder for Brown county; and the same shall be filed within the Auditor's Ordinance Book located in the office of the County Auditor.
