

**BROWN COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 1996-01
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE EVACUATION OF "ON SALE"
ESTABLISHMENTS SELLING INTOXICATION LIQUOR OR NON-INTOXICATING MALT
LIQUOR AFTER THE LEGAL TIME FOR MAKING LICENSED SALES**

THE BROWN COUNTY BOARD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: UNLAWFUL ACTS.

All patrons of an "on sale" establishment selling intoxicating malt liquor must vacate the premises within twenty minutes after the legal time for making licensed sales. Any patron who remains or any licensee or his/her employee who allows a patron to remain beyond the twenty minute limit, is in violation of this ordinance. All employees, with the exception of janitorial or management employees must vacate the premises of an "on sale" intoxicating liquor establishment or a non-intoxicating malt liquor establishment within one hour of the legal termination of sales. Any employee, other than janitorial or management, who is found on the premises after the one hour time limit is in violation of the provisions of the ordinance.

SECTION 2: VIOLATION A MISDEMEANOR.

The violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable as a misdemeanor offense.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance, adopted as amended, shall be in full force and effect from and after 10-1-1996 or the date of its passage and publication to law, whichever occurs first.
