Ordinance No. 2022-2
Lake Hanska Park Campground

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF THE LAKE HANSKA PARK CAMPGROUND UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BROWN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

WHEREAS BROWN COUNTY, through Ordinance No. 2009-01, has provided for the creation and establishment of County Parks, County Monuments, County Recreation Areas, and County Waysides for the purpose of conserving the scenery, natural and historic objects and wildlife therein,

WHEREAS Brown County wishes to specifically regulate the unique uses of the Lake Hanska Park Campground, while incorporating the requirements of Ordinance No. 2009-01.

WHEREAS, authority for regulating the use of parks was granted to the Board of County Commissioners by the provisions of Minn. Stat. 398.34; and WHEREAS, a public hearing, after due notice, as provided in the afore-said Section, has been conducted in regard to this Ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BROWN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 **Purpose:** The purpose of ordaining these rules and regulations is to incorporate Brown County Ordinance 2009-01 herein and to afford additional means of maintaining and enforcing the unique uses of the Lake Hanska Park Campground under the jurisdiction of the Brown County Board of Commissioners.

Section 2 **Adoption and Incorporation by Reference:** Nothing in this Ordinance shall be read to nullify or negate any of the requirements of Brown County Ordinance 2009-01. Brown County Ordinance 2009-01 is hereby incorporated by reference and made a part hereof as if set forth in its entirety. If any of the provisions in this Ordinance shall differ from the provisions of Brown County Ordinance 2009-01, this Ordinance shall govern as it specifically relates to the Lake Hanska Park Campground.

Section 3 **Application And Penalty:** Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to immediate removal from the Campground and shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 4 **Campground Hours:** Registered campers are required to have visitors out of the campground by 10:00 P.M. Campers are encouraged to keep the number of visitors to a minimum.

Section 5 **Quiet Hours:** The hours between 10:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M. are reserved as quiet hours, failure to observe the quiet time hours can result in removal from the campground without refund.

Section 6 **Check in/ Check out:** Check in time is at 1:00 P.M. and Check out time is 11:00 A.M.

Section 7 **Site Occupation:** A campsite equipped for a recreational camping vehicle may be allowed 1 recreational camping vehicle with the addition of a tent as approved by management. Tenting campsites shall be allowed 1 tent, a 2nd tent may be allowed by Management. Each site shall be limited to

groups of six unless all are from the same household. Any occupant less than 18 years old must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian.

Section 8 **Parking:** Each site shall be allowed 1 motor vehicle parked at the site, additional motor vehicles, boats, miscellaneous trailers shall be parked in one of the parking lots located at the park. No motor vehicle, boat, recreational camping vehicle shall be parked on the designated campground road.

Section 9 **Fires:** Fires are permitted only in designated fire rings. Firewood from outside of Brown County is not allowed, firewood can be purchased from the park manager.

Section 10 **Shower house:** The shower house located in the campground is to be used by guests of the campground.

Section 11 **Payment/Cancellation Policy:** Payment is due within 15 days of making the reservation. If reservation is made within 15 days of arrival, payment should be made as soon as possible. Full refund is available if cancellation is made 7 days prior to date of arrival.


Section 12 **ENFORCEMENT:** The Park Supervisor, his designee, or the Sheriff and his Deputies of Brown County in connection with their duties shall enforce the provisions of this Ordinance. They shall have the authority to eject from the park any person acting in violation of this Ordinance. The County Sheriff and Deputies shall have the authority to seize and confiscate any property, thing, or device in the park which violates the Ordinance.


Section 13 **SEPARABILITY:** Should any section of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be involved.

Section 14 **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be effective upon its due passage.
