**Order and Notice for Preliminary
Hearing**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, the Brown County Board of Commissioners, seated as the Drainage Authority for the improvement of County Ditch (CD) 44, pursuant to statutes chapter 103E, shall hold a public hearing on the Preliminary Survey Report prepared for the petition for the improvement of CD 44. The Preliminary Survey Report provides four options for improvement. The Preliminary Survey Report estimates \$1,262,711 of separable benefits out of the total estimated cost of \$1,559,541 for option 1; \$1,045,826 of separable benefits out of the total estimated cost of \$1,320,787 for option 2; \$926,804 of separable benefits out of the total estimated cost of \$1,147,678 for option 3; and \$1,262,711 of separable benefits out of the total estimated cost of \$1,455,441 for option 4. The Board will discuss using separable maintenance at the hearing. The hearing shall be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 4, 2021, in the Training Room at the Brown County Law Enforcement Center, 15 S Washington Street, New Ulm, MN 56073. The petitioners and all other interested parties may appear and be heard.
