PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, the Joint Blue Earth, Brown and Watonwan Counties Board, acting as the drainage authority for Judicial Ditch 48, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 103E.806, shall hold a public hearing on the Petition for Partial Abandonment for portions of Judicial Ditch 48, affecting Branch 6, Lateral D, Sub. Lateral 1A, land located in Section 15, Range 29, Butternut Valley Township, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. **The hearing shall be held at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 2, 2021.** Due to current restrictions the hearing will be held virtually. The details regarding the hearing and how to participate can be found below. The petitioners and all other interested parties, including benefited landowners, are encouraged to attend and be heard.
