ORDER FOR PUBLIC HEARING

At a public meeting conducted by the Joint Brown and Blue Earth County Board sitting as the drainage authority for Judicial Ditch 10 on March 7, 2023 it was moved and seconded to adopt the following Findings and Order:


Findings:

1. The Joint Brown and Blue Earth County Board is the drainage authority for Judicial Ditch 10 (JD 10).
2. On February 5, 2019, The Joint Brown and Blue Earth County Drainage Authority adopted findings and an order for the Redetermination of Benefits of JD 10 and appointed viewers and an engineer.
3. The viewers completed their work and presented a preliminary report to landowners at a meeting held on February 2, 2023.
4. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. 103E., a public hearing must be noticed by mail to petitioners, owners of property, and political subdivisions likely to be affected by the proposed drainage proceeding.

Order:

Based on the foregoing Findings and the entire record of proceedings before the Board, the Board, acting as the drainage authority for JD 10 hereby orders as follows:

1. A hearing on the viewers report shall be held on April 5th at 10:30 a.m. in the Training Room, basement level, of the Brown County Law Enforcement Center, 15 S. Washington St., New Ulm, MN 56073.
2. The Brown County Auditor-Treasurer Department shall mail notice of the time and location of the hearing to petitioners, owners of property, and pollical subdivisions likely to be affected by the Redetermination of Benefits.
