

PUBLIC NOTICE and OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT

The Brown County and Renville County Highway Departments propose to replace Bridge 2110 on Brown County CSAH 8 and Renville County CSAH 3 over the Minnesota River, including new road approaches on both sides of the bridge.

In accordance with Section 6009 of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users (SAFETEA-LU) Public Law 109-59, enacted August 10, 2005, the Brown County and Renville County Highway Departments are soliciting comments on the effects this project would have on the Nesburg's Landing AMA. The project will impact 1.01 acres of the AMA and restrict fishing access in the construction zone during construction of the project. No fishing access will be affected after the project.

It is anticipated that the Brown County and Renville County Highway Departments will request the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to determine that the proposed action at the Nesburg's Landing AMA is a Section 4(f) *de minimis* action in accordance with Section 6009(a) of SAFETEA-LU. A *de minimis* finding may be made when uses of Section 4(f) land will have no adverse effect on the protected resources.

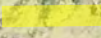
