Minnesota Statute Section 626.556, A person who has knowledge of or reason to believe that a child is being (or in the past 3 years) neglected or physically or sexually abused shall **immediately make an oral report** to be followed as soon as possible by a report in writing. Any person participating in good faith and exercising in due care in the making of a report shall have immunity from any liability civil or criminal.
