

## Liquor License

Minnesota Statute Chapter 340A.403 requires that:

- **“The governing body of a city or county** may issue off-sale or on-sale licenses for the sale of 3.2 percent malt liquor within their respective jurisdictions.”

## Required Forms

## Required Identification

Notarization requires a Driver’s License or State Identification Card.

## Required Fees

The license fee varies depending on the type of licenses you apply for. For confirmation of the fee, please contact the Brown County License Bureau.

Buyer’s Card fees must be separate from the application/license fees.

The Brown County License Bureau can only accept checks or cash.

## How To Obtain

1. Fill out the 3.2 Liquor License application form (or AGE Forms, if applicable).
2. The application form must be signed by a Notary Public. The Brown County License Bureau provides Notary services.
3. Complete the Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division Buyer’s Card and Application (if applicable).
4. Complete the Dram Shop Insurance Form.
5. Complete the Certificate of Compliance form.
6. Then submit, either in person or via mail, the application, Dram Shop Insurance form, Certificate of Compliance and required fees to:
