

Tobacco License

Minnesota Statute Chapter 461 requires that:

- **“An application** for a license to sell licensed products shall be made on a form provided by the county.”

Required Forms

Required Identification

Notarization requires a Driver’s License or State Identification Card.

Required Fees

The license fee is \$200.00. The Brown County License Bureau can only accept checks or cash.

How To Obtain

1. Fill out the Tobacco License application form.
2. The application form must be signed by a Notary Public. The Brown County License Bureau provides Notary services.
3. Download and maintain for your records the Brown County Ordinance adopted December 1, 2020.
4. Complete the Department of Revenue License Application to Make Retail Sales of Cigarette and Other Tobacco Products form.
5. Complete the certificate of Compliance form.
6. Then submit, either in person or via mail, the County Tobacco Application, Department of Revenue Application, Certificate of Compliance and required \$200 fee to:
