
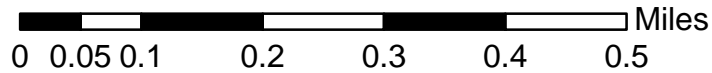


Clear Lake, Brown County

Status of the Fishery (as of 08/25/2003)

Clear Lake is a small (335 acre) shallow lake located south of New Ulm in Brown County. An assessment of the fish population in Clear Lake was conducted in late August 2003 to monitor the fish community following the April 2000 reclamation. Black crappie were abundant in the trap net catches. Most black crappie were around 6 or 9 inches in length and should provide good fishing opportunities. Most bluegill were around 6 inches long. A few 14- inch walleye were captured and were likely from the 2001 fingerling stocking. Carp were first observed in 2001 and in 2003 ranged from 15 to 25 inches. No black bullhead were captured. Largemouth bass are also present.
