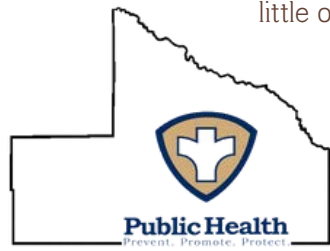

What happens at my home visit?

A Public Health Nurse will complete an assessment related to postpartum recovery as well as an assessment related to newborn growth and development.

The nurse will have information and answer any questions you may have in the following areas:

- postpartum recovery
- infant feedings
- infant cares
- home/vehicle safety
- family adjustments

The nurse provides every family with a gift bag that includes a 'Your Healthy Child' informational binder, a 'tummy time' quilt, books, infant toys, and more!

In addition the nurse will provide assistance with getting connected to resources in our community that can benefit families. Including the Follow Along Program (provides caregivers information on their child's growth and development during the first three years of life) and Imagination Library (book mailed to your home every month until age 5)!



The cost of your Universal Contact Home Visit may be covered by your individual insurance program. In the case that it is not, the cost of the visit will be entirely covered by contributions from the following organizations:
