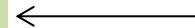


Phased Approach to Vaccine Distribution

1a – First Priority	<p>Hospital personnel working in direct patient care.</p> <p>Long term care Facilities (skilled nursing facilities, staff and residents)</p> <p>Emergency Medical Services Personnel (EMS/EMR) providing direct patient care</p> <p>COVID testers</p> <p>COVID community vaccinators</p>	<p>Hospitals</p> <p>Local Public Health</p>	<p>Pfizer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two dose series 21 days apart <p>Moderna</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two dose series 28 days apart
1a- Second Priority	<p>Hospitals – any personnel not included in the first phase</p> <p>Long Term Care Facilities (Assisted livings/ housing with services) – Staff and residents</p> <p>Urgent Care Settings – all personnel providing direct patient care</p> <p>Dialysis Centers – all personnel providing direct patient care</p>	<p>Hospitals</p> <p>Local Public Health</p>	<p>Pfizer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two dose series 21 days apart <p>Moderna</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two dose series 28 days apart
1a – Third Priority	<p>All remaining health care personnel :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - hospitals - ambulatory care - home health settings - emergency shelters - dental offices - pharmacies - public health clinics - mental/behavioral health settings - correctional settings (nurses and physicians) - group homes - funeral directors 	<p>Hospitals/ Local Public Health</p>	<p>Pfizer/Moderna</p>

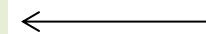

Phased Approach to Vaccine Distribution

<p>1b</p>	<p>Frontline Essential Workers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - fire fighters (not already vaccinated with EMR) - police officers (not already vaccinated with EMR) - food and agricultural workers - United States Postal Services workers - manufacturing workers grocery store workers - public transit workers - educational sector (teachers, support staff, and daycare workers.) <p>People aged 75 years of age and older (those living in a long term care facility should be vaccinated in phase 1a).</p>	<p>Local Public Health</p>	<p>Moderna</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two dose series 28 days apart
<p>1c</p>	<p>People aged 65-74 years (those living in a long term care facility should be vaccinated in phase 1a). Those with underlying health conditions</p> <p>General Public</p>	<p>Local Public Health</p>	<p>Moderna</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Two dose series 28 days apart
