## Money

- The jail only accepts cash, money orders and cashier checks and should be made out to in-mates.
- Personal checks are not accepted.
- The money will be credited to the inmates account for their use.
- The jail staff is not allowed to share information about inmate's account with anyone other than the inmate.
- Money will be only be accepted during visitation hours, through mail anytime or it can be deposited into an inmate's account at [www.jailpayments.com](http://www.jailpayments.com).

## Telephones

- Messages are not taken for inmates.
- If you wish to leave a message for an inmate, you may do so by calling the inmate voicemail system at (507) 571-2751. These messages are not confidential.
- Inmates may purchase phone cards from the jail. They can also be purchased online at [www.reliancetelephone.com](http://www.reliancetelephone.com)
- These cards are available in the amounts of \$10, \$20, and \$50
- Our phone system only accepts these phone cards.
- Any other phone cards do not work in our jail phone.
- You may also set up collect calls for inmates by calling 1-800-896-3201.

## Inmate Visitation

### Visiting hours at the jail are:

Sunday	8:30 – 11:30 A.M.
Monday	9:00 – 11:30 A.M.
Thursday	7:30 – 10:00 P.M.

## Visiting Rules

- All visitors need to call the jail 24 hours in advance to schedule a visit with an inmate.
- Efforts are made to allow visiting time for everyone.
- Inmates are allowed 1 visitor per visiting day.
- Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and are allowed to visit a parent or legal guardian.
- Visits will be 20 minutes in length.
- All visitors must provide photo identification.
- Visits can be denied, refused, or terminated for the safety and security of the jail.
- No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be allowed to visit.
- Visitors must be signed in 30 minutes prior to the end of visiting to receive a full 20 minute visit.

## Inmate Mail

- All mail must come through the United States Post Office.
- Only mail that comes through the Post Office will be delivered to the inmate.
- All mail is subject to inspection by jail staff.
- The inmate may purchase stamps and envelopes through the jail canteen.
- The jail does not accept stamps, envelopes or mail left by visitors for the inmates.

## General Information

- Brown County Jail allows photos with the exception of Polaroid photos. These photos may not include gang graffiti, unclothed persons, and photos with alcohol or cigarettes.
- Huber work release and STS programs are available to inmates that qualify.
- Religious and self-help programs are available to all inmates.
